

Congratulations to the following students for their outstanding accomplishments:

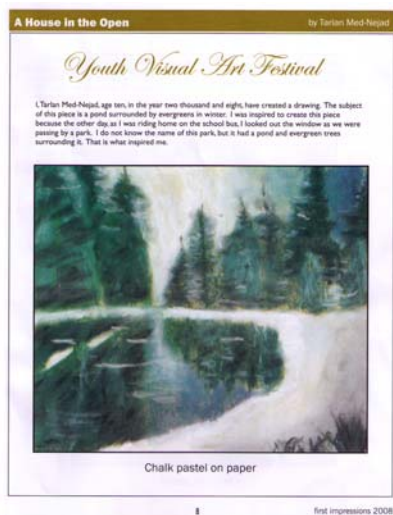
Kristen Chen (Gr.) received the University of Toronto National Book Award.
